Junk Truck Purchasing Guide 2019

**The purpose of the JUSTJUNK® ordering guide is as follows:**

- a) To efficiently guide Franchise Partners through the process of purchasing / leasing a JUSTJUNK® truck.
- b) To standardize the truck specifications across the fleet to JUSTJUNK® approved specifications.
- c) To maximize fleet volume purchasing power while keeping the transactions as straightforward as possible. Hence, there is now one chassis dealer and one dump body/tool cabinet builder/installer as approved vendors.

The designated chassis dealer will be prioritizing stocking of the NPRHDG gas units to JUSTJUNK® specifications to meet the projected demand based on franchise owners development schedules. The dealer will arrange special JJFC fleet factory discounts on behalf of JUSTJUNK® and it is the responsibility of JUSTJUNK® to ensure our vendor is providing competitive pricing.

*Note: JUSTJUNK® can't guarantee the chassis price will always be the lowest price in the country and will not modify the truck vendors and entire ordering process in the event a franchise owner finds a chassis that is a few hundred dollars less as this drives thousands of dollars in labor / admin costs to the Franchisor and Franchisee and jeopardizes the consistency of the end product and associated warranties.*

## ***How To Order Your Truck***

Fill out the truck order form attached on (Schedule 1) and forward to your *Franchise Support Manager, Shane Wright*:

Once we have received your signed order, will forward your order to our truck vendor who will contact you to review all required paperwork. You have the option of negotiating your lease / finance rate with the Vendor or any financial institution of your choice.

Once a contract has been signed with Premier Group Hamilton and a deposit made, this dealer will do the following for us:

- 1) Order the dump body issuing a P.O. to Commander
- 2) Deliver the chassis to Commander at Strathroy. At this stage, the franchise owner is required to contact their insurance company and add the vehicle to their insurance policy.
- 3) Upon the completion of the box, Commander will issue a NSM (National Safety Mark) that effectively states that the vehicle will comply Transport Canada regulations.
- 4) Return the chassis to Premier Group in Hamilton with dump body, installed and painted to the JUSTJUNK® color scheme.
- 5) Carry out Pre-delivery Inspection (PDI). At this point the vehicle warranty commences and it is ready for collection, FOB Premier Group Hamilton.
- 6) Arrange with our decal vendor the supply and installation of JJFC decals, CVOR and MOE decals at Premier Group Hamilton.
- 7) Premier Group will transport the vehicle to a weight scale to determine the TARE weight and provide JUSTJUNK® with the

TARE weight so decals can be produced and shipped directly to the franchise owner.

- 8) Coordinate with JJFC/GeoTab for installation of modem/GPS at East Gate.
- 9) If required, coordinate delivery of the truck with our appointed truck transportation vendor *Acadian Driveaway, Joe Aprile*, [joe@acadiandriveaway.ca](mailto:joe@acadiandriveaway.ca), 416-679-1977.

### **Commander Warranty Agreement**

Please see attached Schedule 2, the warranty agreement from Commander, which covers the scope and procedure when service is needed.



### **LIMITED WARRANTY FOR DUMP BODY**

Commander Industries warrants each dump body sold to the original purchaser and installed on the original chassis to be free of defects in material and workmanship as set forth herein.

THIS WARRANTY IS MADE SOLELY TO THE ORIGINAL PURCHASER AND IS GIVEN IN LIEU OF ANY AND ALL OTHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES. THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE ARE EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMED.

#### **1-year Coverage.**

This warranty is for a period of 1 year from the date of delivery to the original purchaser. It covers all items including wiring, paint, and underbody sealants, entire hydraulic system.

#### **3-year Coverage.**

This warranty is for a period of 3 years from the date of delivery to the original purchaser. It covers the structural mounting of the body to the chassis by Commander Industries and mounting hardware and components supplied by Commander Industries (not including hydraulic components). It also covers, body fasteners, joint sealants and the installation of 3rd party equipment

#### **3 rd Party Equipment Coverage**

Where applicable, 3rd party manufacturers documented warranty on parts installed by Commander will be honored. I.e. PTO's, electric/hydraulic pumps, hoists, lighting, hardware etc.

#### **Not covered under warranty**

Defects in chassis and or power unit

Defects in products not manufactured by Commander Industries.

Defects in products installed by Commander Industries specified to be installed by customer. (Only manufacturer's warranty will be honored).

Deterioration caused by corrosive, hazardous or unsafe cargo.

Deterioration caused by normal wear and tear.

Deterioration due to misuse, abuse, lack of regular recommended maintenance (lubrication), acts of nature, including, but not limited to hurricanes, tornadoes, winds, snow, hail, floods or fire, or other contingencies beyond the control of Commander Industries.

Mounting or re-mounting not performed by Commander Industries.

Commander Industries is not responsible for vehicle down time or travel time required to repair unit. Damage caused to 3rd party equipment.

It is strongly recommended that you (the franchisee) find local vendors capable of performing any potential hydraulic work and aluminum fabrication as needed as quickly as possible.

It shall be the Customer's responsibility to contact Commander Industries at 905-703-0686 between the hours of 8:00a.m. Atlantic time and 5:00p.m. Pacific time before any repairs are made which are covered by or affect this warranty, in order to secure Commander Industries approval. Commander Industries shall, at its option, provide a factory or local representative to inspect the equipment prior to issuing approval. Commander Industries may choose to have the vehicle returned to our plant for in house modifications at no cost to the customer. Commander Industries reserves the right to make changes or improvements in design or product without thereby obligating itself to make the same changes or improvements upon its product previously manufactured.

Understanding that a warrantable issue could occur outside the hours noted above that could require immediate action, digital pictures clearly detailing the situation must be taken and provided to Commander Industries electronically within 24 hours of the occurrence along with any documentation concerning same. It would be solely at the discretion of Commander Industries to subsequently assess whether or not the occurrence is deemed to be warrantable.
